CAREER PREPARATION AND AWARENESS at YORK HIGH SCHOOL

York Public Schools is thrilled to be a statewide leader in school-to-career preparation. We are excited about the numerous opportunities and partnerships we have that provide our high school students with a wide array of excellent experiences.

We currently offer 15 career academies where our 11th and 12th graders can learn about agribusiness management, nursing, marketing, crop science, welding, medical terminology, website design, and more.

We also have a one-of-a-kind Agronomy Academy that began in August 2014 where students from York, Centennial, and Seward learn together at the Monsanto Production Plant near Waco. This hands-on experience is paid for by Pioneer, Monsanto, Mycogen, and Syngenta.

In 2015-16, we will be rolling out some work certification programming through the Nebraska College of Technical Agriculture where YHS students will be able to graduate with a high school diploma AND work certification in diversified agriculture, irrigation technology, or chemical application. This is the first program of its type in Nebraska and we're proud THE DUKES are leading the way!

<mark>DID YOU KNOW....</mark>

- York Public Schools became a school district on June 14, 1871.
- York High School underwent over \$14 million in construction during 2012-13. We added 25,000 square feet with the addition of a fine arts wing for new art, music, and band classrooms, as well as a 2nd gym.
- YHS One-Act has won back-to-back STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS in 2013 and 2014.
- YHS had state runner-ups in softball (2013), football (2013), girls' track (2014), and wrestling (2015).
- YPS had a PreK-12th grade enrollment of 1,325 in 2014-15.
- York Public Schools ranks in the top 25% of Nebraska for student achievement scores in reading, math, and science.
- A brand new York Middle School opened in 2007 and sits on the east side of Delaware Avenue just across from YHS.
