

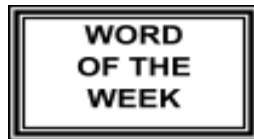

York Public Schools is participating in the USDA's waiver which allows schools to operate the Seamless Summer Option (SSO) for School Year 2021-2022. Your student will receive meals at no cost for the entire 2021-2022 school year. Although your student will be receiving meals at no cost, completion of the application is important for the following reasons: P-EBT Benefits, Fee Waivers and Health Insurance, School Benefits. Important: Your student(s) will continue to receive meals at no cost for the 2021-22 school year regardless of the eligibility determination of your household's SY2021-22 application.



PEANUT/NUT SAFE SCHOOL

Last year York Public Schools chose to become a Peanut / Nut safe school. This means that we all need to be aware of those students and staff that may have any allergy so severe it could be life threatening and could cause death. We want to keep everyone safe so please be mindful when bringing food into the school, never share food with others, wash your hands before and after eating anything with peanuts/peanut butter or other types of nuts. When possible we ask that you contain food to your area that others may be allergic to and clean up your area with soap and water or wipes in rooms.
