-Burke Scholarship through the Upper Big Blue NRD is now open for applications. Student must be pursuing careers in natural resources related fields and furthering their studies at a Nebraska college or university. The online application is available at upperbigblue.org/education Deadline is March 25, 2022.

York County Farm Bureau Scholarship – is open to a graduating senior pursuing an agriculture-related field. While not required, a member of York County Farm Bureau will be preferred. Personal statement required. Applications available in Counseling Office. Deadline is Feb. 28, 2022.

Sydney Loofe Memorial Scholarship (presented by The Set Me Free Project) is open to students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who plan to attend an institution of higher learning in the areas of sociology/criminal justice, countering human trafficking, social work or cyber safety. A personal statement of 500-900 words is required along with other supporting documentation. See Mrs. Stuhr for application information. Deadline is April 25, 2022.

SENIORS: If you are considering UNL for your future plans, in order to be considered for scholarships, in-state students must apply for admission by <u>Feb. 1</u>. UNL is test optional as far as scholarships go, but they will still need your ACT scores. See Counseling office if you have questions.

SENIORS: Wayne State College offers a relatively new scholarship Career Scholars Cooperative Education Program. This one-of-a-kind opportunity allows students to complete their core education on campus in three years and spend their senior year living, learning and earning in one of three communities--Norfolk, Grand Island or Columbus. This scholarship is valued at nearly \$24,000 over four years for tuition and housing.
