NEWS FROM THE COUNSELOR'S OFFICE

- **Blue Valley Community Action (BVCA) Partnership** is now accepting applications for the 2021-2022 BVCA Partnership Scholarship (those attending a four-year school – valued at \$1,000), the BVCA Partnership Vocational Scholarship (those attending a two-year school – valued at \$1,000) and the BVCA Partnership SCC Scholarship (those attending SCC – valued at \$1,000). Applications can be found on-line at www.bvca.net OR you may obtain an application in the counseling office. Three recommendation letters are required. These scholarships are based on financial need guidelines and student must be living in the BVCA service area. Deadline March 1, 2022.

ACCUPLACER TEST will be given at YHS on Wednesday, Nov. 3. This test is needed for community college acceptance and class placement. It is also a way to achieve required scores to take some SCC dual credit courses your junior/senior years at YHS. Please sign up in the Counseling office. Visit with the Counseling office staff if you have any questions.

-**ASVAB Testing** – Sophomores, juniors and seniors who are interested in taking the ASVAB test, which is the military aptitude test as well as a great career exploration and planning tool, it's coming up soon at YHS. There is no fee for this test. You can take it for the career-related results or for future military opportunities. Students are encouraged to sign up in the counseling office for the October 27 test by Monday, Oct. 25. This will be held from 8:30-11:30 AM.

-**DUAL CREDIT TUITION PAYMENTS** are due soon. The deadline at SCC is Oct. 29. The deadline at Peru is November 1. Contact Mrs. Stuhr if you need assistance with the steps to online payments for SCC. Also several students still owe YHS material fees. Mrs. Stuhr has emailed those reminders to students.

HAGAN Scholarship – must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.75 high school GPA and be in the top 20% of class. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours per year of each academic year. This award can be up to \$6,000 per semester, and it is renewable. FAFSA EFC must be less than \$6,500. Applications can be downloaded at haganscholarships.org Deadline is Dec. 1, 2021.

Answer to Question of the Day: (B)
