


Hunter Folts- 2nd place Art, 2nd place Music, 1st place Math, 3rd place Economics, 2nd place Science.






NEWS FROM THE COUNSELING CENTER

SENIORS: Reminder that there are <u>three scholarships</u> listed on the York Community Foundation website <u>yorkcommunityfoundation.org</u> that are available to you! They are: **Chris Nelson Memorial** (ag related), **Hirschfeld Family** (ag related) and **JoDelle A Obermier**. The deadline for these scholarships is March 3, 2020. See Mrs. Stuhr if guestions.

York PEO Chapter IO is sponsoring a scholarship for senior girls with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. See Mrs. Stuhr for application. Deadline is Feb. 15, 2020.

SENIORS with UNL on your radar for next year, a message from UNL staff is as follows. FEBRUARY 1 is the deadline for scholarship applications. Students must have completed their application to Nebraska to qualify for merit-based scholarships. To qualify for leadership and diversity enhancement scholarships, students must also submit a 500-word scholarship statement.

SCHOLARSHIP – Chapter A P.E.O. is offering scholarships to York County senior girls. Requirements include financial need, planning to attend two or four year college and a minimum of "B" grade point average and a resident of York County. PEO relationship is not required. Please include two letters of recommendation. The deadline is February 27, 2020. (Interviews may be conducted.) See Counseling Office for application.

York County Farm Bureau Scholarship – is open to a graduating senior. While not required, a member of York County Farm Bureau will be preferred. Personal statement required. Applications available in Counseling Office. Deadline is March 1, 2020.

Better Business Bureau offers scholarships to graduating seniors, with greatest emphasis placed on ethical behavior, personal integrity, humility, courage, compassion and respect for others. Application information can be found by clicking on the Student Integrity Award Scholarships icon on BBB's website at bbb.org/Nebraska Deadline is March 6, 2020.

Nebraska Czechs of York Scholarship – A \$300 scholarship is available to a nearby high school senior. Selection will be based on high morals, character, academic achievement, participation in school and extra-curricular activities, employment history, leadership and community involvement in keeping the Czech heritage alive. Application can be found at nebraskaczechsofyork.org and is due March 13, 2020.

Central Nebraska Auto Club is offering scholarships to seniors who are Nebraska residents, American citizens, have applied to a Nebraska college or trade school and interested in an auto-related study. Essay required of 100 words explaining future goals, interest in auto-related field and financial need for assistance. Application may be picked up in the Counseling office. Deadline March 25, 2020.

AES Engineering Scholarship -- to be eligible you must answer the essay question in 500-1000 words, *When you look back on your life in 30 years, what would it take for you to consider your life successful? What relationships or accomplishments will be important on this journey?* There is no application packet. Do not send a resume.
