A **University of Nebraska-Kearney representative** will be here at YHS on Tuesday, Jan. 28, during seventh period (1:46 PM). Students interested in learning more about UNK should please sign up in the counseling office. Also remember to pick up a "college rep excuse pass" when you sign up.

SENIORS with UNL on your radar for next year, a message from UNL staff is as follows. **FEBRUARY 1** is the deadline for scholarship applications. Students must have completed their application to Nebraska to qualify for merit-based scholarships. To qualify for leadership and diversity enhancement scholarships, students must also submit a 500-word scholarship statement.

York PEO Chapter IO is sponsoring a scholarship for senior girls with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. See Mrs. Stuhr for application. **Deadline is Feb. 15, 2020.**



**SCHOLARSHIP** – Chapter A P.E.O. is offering scholarships to York County senior girls. A. Capitalization --The noun "dean" is not a name/proper noun, so the capitalization is incorrect.

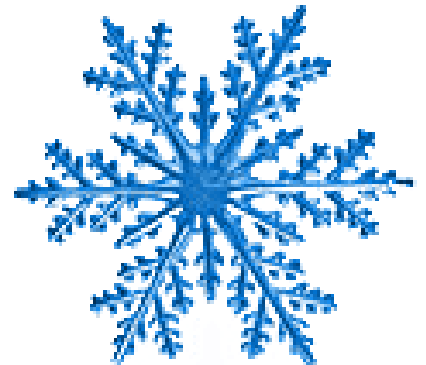
