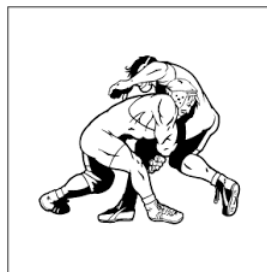
York's next performance will be Saturday, November 21 at 10 am at York.

Answer to question of the day



C: When using two adjectives that could have “and” between them (“large and rambling”), separate the adjectives with a comma. If “and” cannot be inserted, no comma is used. Consider the sentence “They own an expensive summer home.” You would not say “They own an expensive and summer home.” “Across the street from” is a prepositional phrase modifying the noun “house.” It indicates where and provides a connection to “the school.” Interrupting this phrase with a comma is incorrect. The adjectives modify the noun “house.” There is no reason to put a comma between “rambling” and “house.”
