On To College (formerly John Baylor) test prep for the December ACT test will begin over lunch on Friday, Nov. 22 **Sign up in advance is required** and is now available in the Counseling office. The cost is \$75 (payable to YHS) and must be paid at the time you sign up. 😊 Students who paid last spring or this fall may also attend, but sign up is required if you want materials prepared. Perennial Public Power District Scholarship – If you are planning to enroll in a utility line program, a \$1,000 scholarship could be waiting for you. See counseling office for application and more details. Deadline is December 31, 2019.

Norris Public Power District is offering a Utility Line – Electric Lineman scholarship to a young person who will be a graduate within the past two years. The student must have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, rank in the top 50% of the class, and be accepted at Northeast Community College (Norfolk) or Metropolitan Community College (Omaha). *The parents or step-parents must be customers of Norris Public Power District.* If you meet these qualifications, the application can be found at www.norrisppd.com and click on the tab “Community” then “utility line scholarship.” Deadline is December 31, 2019.
