ACT Test --- Students who plan to take the October 24 ACT test need to register by Friday, Sept. 25, at <u>act.org</u> York will NOT be a testing site this year. Seward and Geneva (and other sites) may still have openings for the October test. We strongly suggest you register as soon as possible. Remember to <u>include the York High School code of 282-590</u> when you register!

HORATIO ALGER SCHOLARSHIP ... is now open to seniors who have at least a 2.0 GPA, require financial assistance (\$55,000 or less AGI), be pursuing a bachelor's degree at a public or private institution in the United States (students may start their studies at a two-year institution and then transfer to a four-year college/university), display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, have courage and be a U.S. citizen. Apply on their website at www.scholar.horatioalger.org See the Counseling Center if you have questions. Deadline is October 25 so get started

HAGAN Scholarship – must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.75 high school GPA and be in the top 20% of class. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year. This award can be up to \$6,000 per semester, and it is renewable. FAFSA **EFC** must be less than \$6,500. Applications can be downloaded at haganscholarships.org Deadline is Nov. 15, 2020.
