COOLIDGE SCHOLARSHIP FOR JUNIORS: Junior students who are American citizens and plan to enroll in college the fall of 2025 are eligible to apply for the Coolidge Scholarship. Academic excellence is the primary criterion. Secondary criteria include an interest in public policy and an appreciation of the values President Coolidge championed. Essays are required.
