SENIORS and PARENTS: NOW is the time to get the FAFSA completed as part of your college-planning path. See Mrs. Stuhr to schedule a FREE appointment with our EducationQuest representative if you'd like her help! She's awesome! The next available appointment date is February 7.

Doane University Representative: Will be at YHS on Tuesday, February 13 during fourth period (10:30 am). Students interested in learning more about Doane University should please sign up in advance in the counseling office. Also remember to pick up a "college excuse pass" when you sign up!

HAGAN Scholarship: Must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.5 high school GPA. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year. Must maintain a 4 year or less graduation schedule. This award can be up to \$7,500 per semester, and it is renewable. Applicant's adjusted gross household income for 2022 must not exceed \$100,000. FAFSA report required. Brochures with additional details can be found in the counseling office. Applications can be downloaded at haganscholarships.org. The deadline is March 1, 2024.
