-SENIORS and PARENTS: NOW is the time to get the FAFSA completed as part of your college-planning path. See Mrs. Stuhr to schedule a FREE appointment with our EducationQuest representative if you'd like her help! She's awesome! The next available appointment date will be **Feb 7**.

-SENIORS: Road to Success Scholarship (\$1,000) is now offered to seniors who have a personal auto policy with Grinnell Mutual, Grinnell Select or Grinnell Compass as a policy holder or dependent driver listed on the policy. Senior must have a 3.0 or higher GPA, a clean driving record, attending an accredited higher learning institution in the fall of 2024 and not be a dependent of any Grinnell Mutual employee. Visit their website at www.grinnellmutual.com to complete the online application. More details available in the counseling office. Deadline is March 15, 2024.

- HAGAN Scholarship – must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.5 high school GPA. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year. Must maintain a 4 year or less graduation schedule. This award can be up to \$7,500 per semester, and it is renewable. Applicant's adjusted gross household income for 2022 must not exceed \$100,000. FAFSA report required. Brochures with additional details can be found in the counseling office. Applications can be downloaded at haganscholarships.org Deadline is March 1, 2024.

Burke Scholarship through the Upper Big Blue NRD is now open for applications. Student must be pursuing careers in natural resources related fields and furthering their studies at a Nebraska college or university. The online application is available at upperbigblue.org/education Deadline is March 22, 2024.
