-HAGAN Scholarship – must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.5 high school GPA and be in the top 20% of class. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year. This award can be up to \$6,000 per semester, and it is renewable. Applicant's adjust gross household income must not exceed \$85,000. Applications can be downloaded at haganscholarships.org Deadline is Dec. 1, 2022.

- The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a program co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC). It's a standardized test that provides firsthand practice for the SAT. It also gives you a chance to enter NMSC scholarship programs and gain access to college and career planning tools. The PSAT/NMSQT measures: critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills and writing skills. Juniors who take this test are considered for the National Merit Scholarship competition. Sophomores are welcome to take it for good practice. Please consider this if you are in the top 20% of your class. Visit with your counselor if you have questions. The test will be given at YHS on Wednesday,Oct. 12. The cost is \$18 (check payable to York High School). Sign up required, with your payment, in the Counseling office by Oct. 7.
