**-SENIORS:** Heisman High School Scholarship recognizes more than 5,000 of the best male and female high school seniors. To be eligible for this recognition, a student must have at least a "B" grade average, participated in school sports, and demonstrated active involvement in the community. Apply at [heismanscholarship.com](http://heismanscholarship.com) Deadline is Oct. 18, 2022, at 5 PM; however, a reviewer must review your application before this deadline. See Counseling office if questions.

**-HAGAN Scholarship** – must enroll at an eligible four-year college or university the first semester following high school graduation, have earned a 3.5 high school GPA and be in the top 20% of class. Must also work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year. This award can be up to \$6,000 per semester, and it is renewable. Applicant's adjust gross household income must not exceed \$85,000. Applications can be downloaded at [haganscholarships.org](http://haganscholarships.org) Deadline is Dec. 1, 2022.
