

YPS has been approved to offer free breakfast and lunch to all K-12 students through the COVID relief fund. Starting Thursday, September 24th, all K-12 students can receive one free breakfast and one free lunch. Students do not have to take the free meal and can purchase all a carte items if they choose. Second meals or any extras are not approved under this waiver and are the parent/guardian's responsibility. This waiver will continue through the end of the school year. No application is needed for the free meals as all students automatically qualify.



Last year York Public Schools chose to become a Peanut / Nut safe school. This means that we all need to be aware of those students and staff that may have any allergy so severe it could be life threatening and could cause death.
