

YPS has been approved to offer free breakfast and lunch to all K-12 students through the COVID relief fund. Second meals or any extras are not approved under this waiver and are the parent/guardian's responsibility. This waiver will end December 22nd or before, if the relief funds run out. No application is needed for the free meals as all students automatically qualify.



Last year York Public Schools chose to become a Peanut / Nut safe school.
