

Risk Dial reminders

As of Friday, Sep. 4, The Four Corners Health Dept. Risk Dial is at 2.0...right on the line between yellow and orange. The Risk Dial gets updated each Friday.

Being in orange does not automatically mean a change in our safety measures or procedures.

Being in orange does not automatically mean schools are going to remote learning or reducing capacity.

The Risk Dial is not the same as the “Phases” of reopening, or and it is not the same as new Directed Health Measures.

Our decisions about school operations are based on the Four Corners Health Dept. Risk Dial, and on conversations with Health Dept. officials.
