Classroom Happenings

1st Grade

First graders have been learning about Native Americans and will continue to learn about them as we introduce Pilgrims during the month of November. First graders will also be working on opinion writing, where we will continue to learn how to write complete sentences and focus on transition words.

3rd Grade

Third grade is a hub of activity! We are becoming quite the multiplication and division champs! We have learned all our facts and will be mastering them all year. We continue to work hard in our Wonders reading program. We have been focusing on different types of text, context clues, author's purpose, prefixes and suffixes. In Writing, we are finishing up a unit on Informative writing, where we researched and wrote about our favorite holiday. We just finished up an exciting unit in Science on engineering where we created, designed, and tested structures using marshmallows and toothpicks. We are now moving on to our Pilgrim Unit, which is always a favorite of 3rd graders. We are looking forward to a great fall and cooler weather!

5th Grade

5th graders have been busy in all their classes. They have adjusted well to rotating between all 5th grade teachers so far this year. In Reading they have been practicing skills such as problem/solution, theme, and finding text evidence. In Science, students are investigating properties of matter, gearing up for our annual Name That Matter event! In Social Studies, students are exploring America's regions. In Grammar and Writing, students have finished informative paragraphs that compare, and are currently learning sentence structures. In reading, students are working on identifying Theme and have started exploring poetry. Math class has started working on equivalent fractions and using strategies to compare fractions.

5th graders have the opportunity to be a part of an awesome group at YES called Student Voice. In Student Voice, they are part of various committees that help out around the school. Some jobs in these committees are doing the morning announcements, planning spirit rallies, and keeping our school looking beautiful. This is a great opportunity to practice leading and serving.

The Nurse's Corner

Vision and hearing screenings have recently been conducted at YES. If your child receives a vision or hearing referral, it does not necessarily mean that there is a problem. The referral letter indicates that your child did not meet the guidelines at the time the screening was performed and a more thorough evaluation is recommended.

Untreated eye and vision problems can affect a child's general health and their daily performance in school and at home. Signs that your child may need to have their vision checked by an eye doctor include:

- Tilting head to one side or thrusting head forward at a funny angle when trying to see something
- Holding objects close to the eye to see
- Sits unusually close to the TV or computer screen
- Squints eyes to see more clearly
- Blinks more than usual
- Has difficulty learning to read
- Frequently experiences headaches, nausea or dizziness.

It is our goal to detect vision or hearing issues before they become a problem so your child can be successful in school and in life. If you receive a letter and seek further evaluation, if you are willing, please send documentation from the evaluation so we may track the outcomes from our screenings. If you have further questions or concerns, do not hesitate to reach out.

A Wall of Honor will be displayed near the office in observance of Veteran's Day. Each child in our school is invited to add the name of a veteran they would like to recognize.
