SUMMER 2024 DRIVER'S EDUCATION

The two sessions of Driver's Education that will be held this summer at York High School are both full. We will continue to take names for a waitlist, with the possibility of adding a third session, from June 3 through June 6. All sessions will be from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm.

Students must have a Learner's Permit (LP) or School Learner's Permit (SLP) by July 15 to be able to complete the driving portion of the class. Driver's Education courses will offer classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel training.

The cost of Driver's Education is \$375.00, checks payable to York High School. If you are interested, please contact the YHS Office. Sign up is on a first come-first serve basis. **The deadline for signing up and payment will be Friday, May 3rd.** Call the YHS Office at 402.362.6655, option 2, to sign your student up.

NOTES FROM THE NURSE

April is National Distracted Driving Awareness month.

It is estimated by the National Safety Council that at least 28 percent of all traffic accidents are caused by drivers using cell phones and texting. While we likely think of cell phone use when we hear the word distracted driving, the CDC lists 3 categories:

Visual - to look at something in the scenery, someone in the backseat or something on a screen in the vehicle

Manual - taking your hands off of the wheel--to eat, to pick something up off of the floor, to fix hair or apply make-up

Cognitive - taking your mind off of your driving by daydreaming or planning for the rest of the day

Some things to consider:

- Use of electronic devices and cell phones involve all 3 types of distraction
- Statistically, people who text and drive spend 10% of their driving time outside of their lane
- Laws prohibit texting and driving in 43 states in the U.S., including Nebraska
- Texting increases the risk of a crash or near-crash by 23 times, with driver distraction being responsible for more than 58% of teen vehicular accidents
- Nearly 80% of drivers admit to hazardous behaviors while behind the wheel, including changing clothes, steering with a foot, or reaching for something other than the steering wheel
- While reading or sending a text message, your eyes will be off of the road for about 5 seconds, which, at 55 mph is long enough to cover the length of a football field. What happens at 75 mph?

Whether you are a parent or a teen driver, be a role model. Don't text, talk on the phone or eat while driving. Make the decision to not ride with others that drive while distracted. Silence devices, put them out of reach and wait to check for messages until you are safely at your destination, and always buckle up!



COUNSELING CENTER NEWS

HONORS NIGHT / SENIORS AND PARENTS

If your student has received college scholarships and/or is planning to go into the **MILITARY (including National Guard)**, please let us know so we can include them in our program. Colleges and other organizations do not always let us know about these and we want to honor those students for their accomplishments.

AFTER HONORS NIGHT

After Honors Night, seniors will be sent important information on how to collect their scholarship funds. An email will be sent to each student via their personal email. (If a parent wishes to also receive this email, please notify Deb Stuhr at deb.stuhr@yorkdukes.org requesting this.) Most scholarships are paid per semester, ***so it's important to hold onto these contacts through second semester because students will be asked to submit information to these committees again.*** If you do not receive the information in a few weeks, please let the counseling office know.

Students are also required to promptly write a thank you note for each scholarship received. The notes are provided by the Counseling office, but postage must be handled by your student.

REMINDER: SUMMER SCHOOL CLASSES FOR CREDIT RECOVERY

Summer school classes for credit recovery will be offered at the Enrichment Center again this year. This is scheduled for May 20-May 24 and May 28-31 (Monday-Friday except Memorial Day) from 8:00 am to noon for students who are at risk of not meeting York High School graduation requirements. Space is limited and priority will be given to first semester failures. There is a fee for attending summer school. A letter will be sent out to parents with at-risk students later in April explaining the process to follow if you want your child to take a class. If you have questions, please feel free to contact your child's counselor as soon as possible.

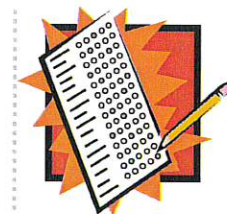
If you are considering college and plan to apply for scholarships, we encourage you take the June and/or July ACT test. Fee waivers for the June and July tests are available until the regular registration deadline of May 3/June 7. ACT scores from tests taken in the junior year are used for Regents scholarship competition. Seniors are also encouraged to consider the test dates in September, October and December for college scholarship consideration. Many scholarships have very early deadlines so taking those earlier tests ensures scores will be available when needed.

FEE WAIVERS:

Cost should never be a deterrent when it comes to college opportunities. If this is an issue for your child, please take full advantage of fee waivers available through the ACT, SAT or the NAIA and NCAA. These are available for our students who qualify for free or reduced lunches. If you would like to know if you qualify or just want to pick up a waiver, you or your student needs to come to the counseling office.

NAIA AND NCAA REGISTRATION

If you want to play sports in college, you will need to register with the NAIA (fee is charged) or the NCAA, depending on the college you wish to attend. These two organizations require ACT scores sent directly from the ACT testing center so you will need to include the NAIA code (9876) or the NCAA code (9999) in your choices of where you want your scores sent. If scores need to be sent later, there is a fee for each score sent. *Please also be sure Mrs. Stuhr is aware of your college sport participation so your final transcript gets sent to these entities.*

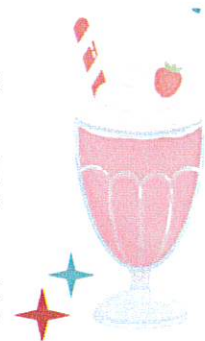
Parents of current 8th graders will be invited to a meeting at the YHS Theater that evening from 5:30 pm to 6:00 pm.

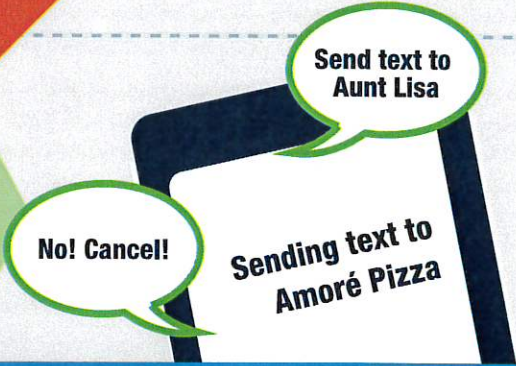


