ACT Test Day - March 25, 2025

Testing season is quickly approaching! Much like in the past, all YHS juniors will be taking the Nebraska State ACT test on March 25th. This test is paid for and administered through the Nebraska Department of Education so parents do NOT need to sign up. All 9th-11th grade students will need to report to YHS by 8:00 am.

Please read below for activities for each class on Tuesday, March 25th:

- ⇒ 9th Graders Traveling to York University for a campus tour, followed by PreACT 8/9 at YHS.
- ⇒ 10th Graders Pre-ACT test administered at York High School.
- ⇒ 11th Graders Nebraska State ACT administered at York High School.
- ⇒ 12th Graders NO SCHOOL for Seniors.

Students in grades 9-11 will be dismissed when their activity is completed. Breakfast will be provided. Lunch will NOT be served that day, but breakfast will be available in the morning. Bussing will run as normal.

Career Fair - April 2, 2025

This year's YCDC Career Fair is scheduled for the morning of April 2nd, at the Holthus Convention Center. We will be taking a number of junior students and the keynote speaker will be Johnny Quinn. This event is put on by York County Development Corporation with several other students from York County participating.

FAFSA - SENIORS

Just a reminder to all seniors and parents about the **STATE GRADUATION REQUIREMENT** of completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). This is critical for any senior attending any type of college as it can affect scholarships as well as federal aid. We are so fortunate to have an on-site EducationQuest representative visit our school on some Thursdays to give FREE assistance with this process. Contact Mrs. Stuhr to set an appointment. March 13 is her next date to visit YHS. Student and parent must create an FSA ID at least three days prior to the completion of the FAFSA.

DUAL CREDIT (SENCAP) THROUGH SCC

Career Academy classes through Southeast Community College are an excellent option for juniors and seniors to experience a vocational area to see if it could be a potential college interest ... or not! If your child is interested in a dual credit class or two (high school and college credit), now is the time to visit with his/her counselor. Education, health sciences, agriculture, information technology, criminal justice, and green energy are just some of the areas covered in this successful program. Some courses are taught at YHS by our teaching staff and others are available online. Registrations will be starting very soon this spring, so NOW is the time to learn more!

DUAL CREDIT - BILLING AND PAYMENTS

According to information received from SCC and Peru State, the following are the dates you need to be mindful of for dual credit billing and payments:

<u>SCC</u> - Bills were emailed to students in late January. This is the email through the SCC account. Tuition payment was due February 20. We are fortunate that students receive a reduced rate due to legislative actions.

<u>Peru</u> - Bills will be mailed in the very near future to the student's home address. They are also accessible on their MyPSC account. Tuition payment is due April 1.

Tuition payments to both colleges should be mailed directly to the college and not to York High School. Paying online through the student's account is also an option. Contact Deb Stuhr in the Counseling office if you have any questions. Also reminder that YHS materials fees (which get turned in to Mrs. Stuhr) are due March 4.

SCAVENGER HUNT

York High School SUMMER 2025 DRIVER'S EDUCATION


We are offering three sessions of Driver's Education this summer!

The classroom portion will be held from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm each day in the choir room at York High School. If you would like to participate, please call YHS as soon as possible.

There is a driving portion also. Students must have a Learner's Permit (LP) or School Learner's Permit (LPE) by July 15 to be able to complete the driving portion of the class. Driver's Education courses will offer classroom instruction and behind-the-wheel training.

The cost of Driver's Education is \$375.00, checks payable to York High School. If you are interested, please contact the YHS Office. Sign up is on a first come-first serve basis.
